Index based on: consultation/joint development with workers, customers, innovators (i.e. think tanks); design approach; VET; social dialogue



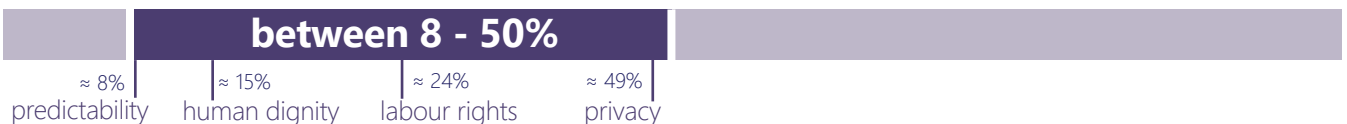
## Quality of digital working conditions
